

Medical and Mental Health Emergencies

Call 911(or 255-1111 from a cell phone) in any emergency that requires immediate police, fire or medical response to preserve a life. These include

- serious injury or illness
- serious mental health issues that might lead to suicide, assault or homicide

Health care consultation is available 24 hours a day. Call Gannett: Cornell University Health Services at 5-5155 (or 255-5155 from a cell phone).

Alcohol Intoxication/ Poisoning

Alcohol poisoning can be fatal.

Do not allow someone who has drunk too much to “sleep it off.”

Stay beside the person and call 911(or 255-1111 from a cell phone) immediately if the person:

- cannot be roused
- is incoherent and is vomiting
- breathes shallowly
- has cold clammy skin
- looks bluish or pale
- has taken other drugs with alcohol
- has a head injury
